As a way to empower women in the developing world Meme Stephens Ministries looks to partner with women in poor communities who are running their own businesses to feed their families. We purchase the crafts or products they make then return 100% of the profits back to the women.



“Juana Palax Chiroy and a group of women from her community were in charge of making the bracelets. They are from Xajaxac Juana Community in the municipality of Sololad, Xajaxac (Guatemala). Juana is the leader of a group of 43 women in the community that receive technical support and resources from Agudesa, a microfinance institution that gives small loans to individuals to help them make a living with their small business. Juana has a reforestation project as well as a small business for producing souveinirs. This women’s group serves not only as a business but also a support group for women in the community.
